The Copeland Forest is a 4,400 acre (1620 ha) Resource Management Area in Simcoe County, Ontario, Canada, owned by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forests (MNRF).

We acknowledge the first peoples who walked this land before us. This Forest is on the traditional territories of the Indigenous Nations and, in particular, the Anishinaabeg, Wendat and Haudenosaunee.

We acknowledge the enduring presence of Indigenous peoples connected to this land. We are grateful for the opportunity to experience this territory and we are committed to moving forward in the spirit of reconciliation and respect.

The Copeland Forest Friends Association (CFFA) is a Non-Profit Corporation with a Memorandum of Understanding with the MNRF. The mandate of CFFA is to conserve the natural integrity of the Forest while facilitating recreational use.

This map illustrates the trail network in the Forest recognized by CFFA and is consistent with the 2024 Trail Plan that was developed after 2+ years of study and engagement of the users and surrounding community. The existing trail network may not yet fully represent this network. Trail improvements are to be made over the next couple of years.

The trails in the forest are primitive, not regularly maintained and have many uneven surfaces including roots, rocks and gullies. Users of the trails do so at their own risk.
